## Facilities :

Library : A spacious library with sufficient sitting capacity and around 2000 text books on Pharmacy (latest editions/volumes) is there in the Department. Besides, the Department is in the process of subscribing twenty five journals relating to field of Pharmaceutical Sciences. Further, about 200 to 250 new books are being added every year. At present the library contains books worth Rs.15 to 20 lakhs.
