Department profile

In order to meet the challenges of globalization and liberalization and to develop an institution of excellence in Legal Education, Kurukshetra University established, the Institute of Law in the Year 2001 on its campus to run 5-Year Integrated Law Course. The object of the Institute is to disseminate legal knowledge that meets the demands of the fast changing Economic, Political and Social Institutions. The emphasis is to look at Law as an instrument of social change and progress and to inculcate amongst students high degree of professionalism with a sense of responsibility towards the society.

The institute is housed in its own building on the campus, the foundation stone of which was laid by the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dr. A.S. Anand, the then Chief Justice of India. It is a modern building complex having a compact area of 60,000 sq. feet with all the infrastructural facilities; comparable to the best in any National Law School in our country.

While faculty and the students comprise the essential human factors in education, the endeavour cannot prosper without adequate Library and Computer facilities. The Institute provides the students with a variety of academic and support resources to enhance their knowledge and experience.

The Institute has its own Library well-stocked with books on Law and other allied subjects with a spacious Reading Hall. The Institute subscribes all the leading Law Reports and Journals of National and International repute.

To be aware of the recent innovations in Computer technology has become pre-requisite for any field of knowledge. It is all the more true in case of legal field.

The Institute boasts of a well-equipped Computer Lab to cater the need of the law students in the field of computer education. Besides, the students have a free access to the Computer Centre of the University.
