Department of Social Work of this University was started in academic session 1981-82 with the objective to produce social engineers who will be able to set an excellence and thoughtful social order and relationship. Presently the need and contribution of the department and its students has been realized to handle the increasing social tension and turmoil of emerging scenario because of that every year almost all the students of the department are being recruited either through campus interview or directly as Human Resource Development Executives, Welfare Officers, Counsellors, Social Workers, Programme Coordinator, Research and Development Officers etc., by Government and NGOs for project formulation, programme implementation, monitoring, evaluation, training and development.

Literature produced/published, research conducted and evaluation done by the faculty of the department and the students are now considered as the best source for teaching, learning and programme implementation. Students of the department during field work twice a week of their course, contribute a lot in bringing better awareness about the developmental programmes introduced from time to time by the government and NGOs.
