## **BRACH PROFILE**

Kurukshetra University National Service Scheme came into existence in 1969 with the objective of providing students youth with an opportunity to develop their overall personality by participating in a variety of social/community service programme.

To assist and guide the NSS Units for implementation of all programme at college level, to help in organizing camps, training and orientation programmes for the eligible NSS proramme officer, to visit NSS units for monitoring & evaluation, to ensure implementation of NSS regular activities and special camping programmes, to ensure timely release of grant to colleges, to submit the reports and returns to Programme Adviser of Regional Centre and the State Liaison Officer, to ensure selection of new programme officers of affiliated colleges and ensure their course within the stipulated period as per the guidelines, to submit half-yearly reports and other information's required by the Govt. of India, Regional Centre and the State Liaison officer on the prescribed proforma, to have a periodical liaison with the Regional Centre, State Liaison Officer and TOC/TORC for implementation of all extension programme, to collect NSS fee from all affiliated colleges other than B.Ed. and to bring out documents and reports on the achievements of NSS and to get the budget approved by the KUNSS Advisory Committee. This cell issues NSS Merit Certificates according to laid down procedure on the recommendations of Screening Committees constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

The Cell functions under the Vice-Chancellor. One Programme Coordinator, NSS is the In charge of the Cell and the main executive functionary. One assistant deals with the general correspondence and one clerk deals with all financial matters. One peon has also been provided at the disposal of the cell.
